As earlier notified the HAHC is organizing an exhibition dedicated to the theme '**The Military Heritage of Haryana**'. A second exhibition on the occasion will be on the '**Significance of Rakhigarhi**'. This will be contributed by Dr. Mohinder Singh, Associate Prof. D.N. College, Hisar.

Prof. AP. Jamkhedkar, Chairman Indian Council of Historical Research, New Delhi will deliver the keynote. He would speak on the importance of the Harappan sites in Haryana and Punjab in the context of the Aryans. Prof. Jamkhedkar has a masters degree in Sanskrit and Linguistics and obtained his Ph.D. from the prestigious Deccan College Pune (Ancient Indian Culture) He has taught at Nagpur University (1968-77) Mumbai University (1978-2018). A renowned archaeologist, he was Director Archaeology and Museums (1977-97) Maharashtra. He has been Vice President of the Asiatic Society Mumbai. At present he is also Chancellor of the Deccan College (Deemed University) Pune and Editor of the **Journal of Asiatic Society** Mumbai.

Prof. Kapil Kapoor, Chairman Indian Institute of Advanced Studies Shimla, will be Chief Guest at the Inaugural. A scholar of languages, linguistics Indian Intellectual Traditions and Sanskrit Knowledge Systems, Prof. Kapoor taught at Delhi University from 1962-1971, at JNU 1972-2005. He has had the distinction of being Professor of English at the Centre for Linguistics and English (JNU) and Concurrent Professor, Centre for Sanskrit Studies (JNU) He was PVC (JNU) and Dean of the School of Languages, Literature and Culture Studies (JNU).
